

How to Use *Pruebas Publicadas en Español*

Pruebas Publicadas en Español (PPE) consists of descriptive listings, without reviews, of commercially available tests in print that are published in part or wholly in Spanish.

1. If you know the TEST TITLE:

Use the “**Index of Titles.**” The index lists all tests described in the volume plus original titles for those tests that served as the basis for a Spanish translation or adaptation (designated as “original” after the title). “417,” for example, refers to test 417 in the volume. *Citation numbers refer to entry numbers, not to page numbers.*

Example from “Index of Titles”:

 Dexterity (original), *see Destreza*, 134

2. If you know the TYPE OF TEST:

Use the “**Classified Subject Index**” to locate various categories of tests, such as achievement, intelligence, personality, etc. This index organizes all tests into 18 major categories; descriptions appear alphabetically by test title within each category. *Citation numbers refer to entry numbers, not to page numbers.*

Example from “Classified Subject Index, Personality”:

Clinical Analysis Questionnaire (original), *see Cuestionario de Análisis Clínico*
 Constructive Thinking Inventory (original), *see Inventario de Pensamiento Constructivo*
 Coopersmith Self-Esteem Inventories for Children and Adults; Ages 8-15, 16 and above, see 71
 Coping Responses Inventory—Adult Form (original), *see Inventario de Respuestas de Afrontamiento para Adultos*
 CPF [Second Edition]; Ages 16-adult, see 72

3. If you know the NAME OF THE TEST AUTHOR, REVIEWER, OR TRANSLATOR/ ADAPTOR:

Use the “**Index of Names.**” This index includes names of test authors (for example, “test, 337”), review authors (“rev, 283”), and translators/adaptors (“t/a, 140”). *Citation numbers refer to entry numbers, not to page numbers.*

Example from “Index of Names”:
