

Guidelines for the Nebraska Certified Seed Scholarship

To be considered for the Nebraska Certified Seed Scholarship, applicants must be currently enrolled graduate students at the University of Nebraska. Candidates should be pursuing advanced studies in plant breeding or a closely related field within the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. A demonstrated interest in the seed industry and involvement in relevant research or professional activities will be favorably considered.

The scholarship provides \$2000, with funds deposited directly into the recipient's UNL account. The scholarship may be used for tuition, research expenses, or other educational costs.
